If the committee is new, the beginning transaction date is the date the committee formed.

The State Board of Elections (SBE) sends a *Pre Report Notice* before each report is due. This notice is only sent if our system indicates that your entity owes the report. If you receive a *Pre Report Notice* that you feel is in error, please immediately contact this office for assistance. Fees will be assessed for campaign finance reports received late. The maximum late fee is \$500 per report.

Delivery Requirements:

- MD CRIS Using any Internet browser, log in at www.campaignfinance.maryland.gov. You can file your campaign finance report up to 11:59pm on the filing deadline. An email will be sent to you verifying the submission of the report.
- Mailed If mailed, the report must either arrive at the State Board on or before the due date, or must be timely postmarked. Acceptable proof of timely mailing includes: (1) a United States Postal Service postmark or receipt; (2) a timely private meter postmark (provided the report was received by this office within 3 days of the due date); or (3) a timely receipt from a private carrier (provided the report was received by this office within 3 days of the due date).
- In Person The report may be delivered in person to the State Board. To be timely, delivery must be no later than the close of business on the due date.

¹ This report is only required for new committees that were not required to file the 2014 Annual Report.

² If the 2014 Annual report was not required for your committee, then the transaction beginning date for this report will be April 9, 2014.

³ This report is only required for candidates running for Central Committee.

⁴ Ballot Issue Committees will use October 6, 2014 as the transaction beginning date.
