The maximum late fee is \$1000 per report.

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Report Delivery Requirements

Delivery Requirements:

- MD CRIS** Using any Internet browser, log in at www.campaignfinance.maryland.gov. You can file your campaign finance report up to 11:59 pm on the filing deadline. An email will be sent to you verifying the submission of the report.
- Mailed** If mailed, the report must either arrive at the State Board on or before the due date or must be timely postmarked. Acceptable proof of timely mailing includes: (1) a United States Postal Service postmark or receipt; (2) a timely private meter postmark (provided the report was received by this office within 3 days of the due date); or (3) a timely receipt from a private carrier (provided the report was received by this office within 3 days of the due date).
- In-Person** The report may be delivered in person to the State Board. To be timely, delivery must be no later than the close of business o
