- Amendments to Article II of the Constitution of Maryland, title “Executive Department”, creating the office of Lieutenant Governor; providing for gubernatorial succession; and providing for the qualifications and joint nomination and election of candidates for Governor and Lieutenant Governor.

- Amendments to the Constitution of Maryland, Article IV, title “Judiciary Department”, and Article XV, title “Miscellaneous”, providing powers of the commission on judicial disabilities; creating a system of District Courts, providing for the appointment and confirmation of judges in these courts, making provision for the jurisdiction, powers, duties, and operations of the District Courts, and abolishing certain other courts and judicial officers being superseded by the District Courts.

- Amendments to Article IV, title “Judiciary Department” of the Constitution, providing that the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate, shall appoint the judges of the Court of Appeals, intermediate courts of appeal, Circuit Courts, and the Supreme Bench of Baltimore City; that all hearings and deliberations on the confirmation of candidates shall be public, and defining the powers of the Commission on Judicial Disabilities.

- An Amendment to the Constitution of Maryland to amend Section 1 of Article I, title “Elective Franchise”, to change the period of residence required of residents of the State to vote, to provide that for purposes of voting for President of the United States, the General Assembly may prescribe by law a lesser residence requirement for citizens who have resided in this State for less than six months.
