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Maryland State Board of Elections Displays 2026 General Election Ballots For Public Review

ANNAPOLIS (August 31, 2026) The Maryland State Board of Elections (SBE) today announced that the 2026 Gubernatorial general election ballots have been certified and are posted for review on its website, <https://elections.maryland.gov/elections/2026/index.html#ballots-gen>.

A registered voter has until close of business on Thursday, September 3 to seek judicial review of the certified ballots. Once the review period ends, SBE will make any necessary changes and begin the ballot printing process. Voters with questions regarding a ballot can email SBE at info.sbe@maryland.gov.

“The certification of the ballot is the first step in the electoral process. As voters familiarize themselves with their ballots, we encourage them to make a plan to vote,” said Jared DeMarinis, State Administrator of Elections. “There are three methods to vote- by mail, in-person early or on Election Day. There is still time to request a mail-in ballot. Please check our website or download our Go Vote Maryland app for more information.”

SBE encourages residents who are not currently registered to vote to do so via SBE’s [online registration system](#). Additionally, registered voters can change party affiliation, update their address, and update their name if it has changed via the same system. Those who prefer not to register online may [print the registration form](#) and submit it at the office of their [local board of elections](#).

Voters can vote in the upcoming General Election in one of three ways: early in-person at select locations, mail-in ballot, or in-person on election day at your designated polling place. Make a plan and vote.

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
